11	CONVENING THE INDEPENDENT CITIZENS' REDISTRICTING COMMISSION AND
12	CALLING FOR THE REDISTRICTING OF THE FOUR CITY OF SANTA FE COUNCIL
13	DISTRICTS PRIOR TO THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION ON NOVEMBER 7, 2023, BASED
14	ON THE RESULTS FROM THE 2020 UNITED STATES CENSUS.

16	WHEREAS, in March 2014, the electorate of the City of Santa Fe approved an amendment
17	to the City's Charter to create an Independent Citizens' Redistricting Commission ("Commission"),
18	Section 6.03; and
19	WHEREAS, Section 6.03 to the City's Charter required the Governing Body, by
20	ordinance, to establish a procedure for the appointment and deliberations of the commission; and
21	WHEREAS, the City's Governing Body adopted Section 6-18, SFCC 1987, which
22	established a procedure for the appointment and deliberations of the Commission; and
23	WHEREAS, the Commission last convened in 2015 to provide updated redistricting for
24	the 2016 municipal election, incorporating the 2014 City annexation of 4100 acres and 13,250 new
25	residents; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 decennial census shows a total population growth of 19,558 residents since the 2010 census, for a total population of 87,505 within the municipal boundaries of Santa Fe; and

WHEREAS, the Commission shall establish a districting plan pursuant to Section 6-18.3(B) SFCC 1987 either:

- (1) Within one (1) year of receipt by the city of the final federal decennial census information for use commencing with the next scheduled general municipal election occurring at least three (3) months after adoption of the final districting plan; or
- (2) When the governing body adopts a resolution expressing the need for convening a commission to establish a districting plan; and

WHEREAS, the City has both received the census information and there is a need to convene the commission to equalize the populations of the four Council Districts before the 2023 election through the process of redistricting; and

WHEREAS, On August 1, 2021, the Census Bureau released census data to the states and the public and the Governing Body desires to convene a Commission as soon as possible to ensure the redistricting is complete with sufficient time prior to the 2023 municipal election; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-18.5(C) describes the process for the City Clerk to determine a reasonable application period, provide a "ministerial" review of the applications, verify the minimum number of applications have been reviewed, and schedule a drawing of members' alternates by lot.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the Independent Citizens' Redistricting Commission shall be convened to update the four city councilor districts, based on the population results of the 2020 Federal Decennial Census.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk shall initiate the process for soliciting
