**A RESOLUTION**

**EXTENDING THE DURATION OF THE MAYOR’S EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION  
RESPONDING TO FIRE RISKS, ISSUED ON MAY 28, 2022, BY SEVEN DAYS,  
EXPIRING AT NOON ON JUNE 7, 2022, PURSUANT TO SFCC 1987, SECTION 20-1.3(C).**

**WHEREAS**, current drought indices indicate all of Santa Fe County is in extreme drought and the seasonal drought outlook indicates that the drought will persist; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body adopted multiple Resolutions (Resolution Nos. 2022-5, 2022-13, 2022-19, and 2022-25) that imposed certain restrictions on fireworks and other activities pursuant to SFCC 1987, Section 12-3.9; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 28, 2022, Mayor Webber issued Proclamation of Emergency – Fire Risk declaring a state of emergency due to very high or extreme fire danger presently exists; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to SFCC 1987, Section 20-1.3(B), a Proclamation of Emergency shall be effective for three (3) days from issuance unless extended by the Governing Body for up to seven (7) days;

**WHEREAS**, due to the ongoing risk to persons and property due to the unusually high risk

1 of fire, the Governing Body wishes to extend the Emergency Proclamation –Fire Risk.

2 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**  
3 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that Proclamation – Fire Risk is hereby extended for seven (7) days from  
4 today, expiring at noon on June 7, 2022, pursuant to SFCC 1987, Section 20-1.3(C).
