| 11 | AMENDING THE IMMIGRATION COMMITTEE'S PURPOSE AND MEMBERSHIP. |
| 12 | WHEREAS, on January 13, 1999, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 1999-6 |
| 13 | declaring a policy of non-discrimination on the basis of a person's national origin and appointing |
| 14 | an immigration taskforce; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, on January 16, 2002, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2002-3, |
| 16 | which renamed the Immigration Taskforce the "Immigration Committee"; and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, on October 9, 2002, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2002-58, |
| 18 | which decreased the number of members on the Immigration Committee from fifteen to nine |
| 19 | members; and |
| 20 | WHEREAS, on October 8, 2014, the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2014-82, |
| 21 | declaring its "continuous" support for immigrant issues in Santa Fe, the state of New Mexico, and |
| 22 | throughout the United States; and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, the Governing Body continues to support the policy of non-discrimination |
| 24 | established by Resolution No. 1999-6; and |
| 25 | WHEREAS, the City's Charter, Article II, Section 2.02, "Human and Civil Rights", states |
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| 1 | that the City holds human and civil rights as inviolate and states that these rights "shall not be |
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| 2 | diminished or otherwise infringed" regardless of "ethnicity, race, age, religion, creed, color, |
| 3 | national origin, ancestry, sex, gender, sexual orientation, physical or mental disability, medical |
| 4 | condition or citizenship status"; and |
| 5 | WHEREAS, the purposes and membership of the Immigration Committee have not |
| 6 | changed since the Governing Body's resolution in 2002; and |
| 7 | WHEREAS, the Governing Body wishes to amend the Committee's purposes and |
| 8 | membership as is shown below: |
| 9 | Section 1. NAME: The committee shall be called the Immigration Committee. |
| 10 | Section 2. PURPOSE: [The committee shall monitor the human rights status of |
| 11 | non-citizens residing in the city of Santa Fe and report its findings and recommendations to the |
| 12 | governing body] The purpose of the Immigration Committee is to advise the City about policies |
| 13 | and actions that would preserve and promote inclusive policies, equal opportunity, and equal |
| 14 | protection for immigrants and immigrant populations in Santa Fe consistent with the City's Charter, |
| 15 | Section 2.02 "Human and civil rights". |
| 16 | Section 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: The committee shall [meet as |
| 17 | necessary to accomplish its purpose and shall follow adopted city policy and procedures] perform |
| 18 | the following duties and responsibilities: |
| 19 | (a) Monitor the human rights status of immigrant populations residing in the city of Santa |
| 20 | <u>Fe.</u> |
| 21 | (b) Advise the City regarding policies, programs, and legislation as they relate to |
| 22 | immigrants and immigrant populations in Santa Fe. |
| 23 | (c) Collaborate with other agencies and/or groups, such as, but not limited to, |
| 24 | county/state/federal agencies, labor organizations, religious groups, healthcare and |
| 25 | educational institutions, immigrant rights groups, and non-profits, to respond to share |

| 1 | resources and information with one another and with the community, and participate |
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| 2 | in any other collaborative activities, as are consistent with the purpose of the |
| 3 | committee, as needed, to support the purposes of the committee. |
| 4 | Section 4. MEMBERSHIP AND OFFICERS: The committee [membership] |
| 5 | shall consist of nine representatives residing in the county of Santa Fe and selected from |
| 6 | the following areas: human rights, social services, business community, health care, labor |
| 7 | organizations, religious community, youth services providers, women's advocacy groups, |
| 8 | educators, and legal services. The members shall be appointed by the mayor with the |
| 9 | [approval] consent of the governing body. The [chairperson shall be appointed by the |
| 10 | mayor] mayor shall appoint the chairperson and the committee shall designate the vice- |
| 11 | chairperson [shall be designated by the committee]. |
| 12 | Section 5. TERMS: The members shall serve for a period of two years. The |
| 13 | committee members shall serve at the pleasure of the mayor and may be removed at any time, with |
| 14 | or without cause. |
| 15 | Section 6. STAFF LIAISON: The city manager shall designate [the intercultural |
| 16 | affairs planner] one or more City staff members, as appropriate, to be liaisons to the committee. |
| 17 | NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE |
| 18 | CITY OF SANTA FE that the amended rules and procedures shall read as follows: |
| 19 | Section 1. The Committee shall be called the Immigration Committee. |
| 20 | Section 2. PURPOSE: The purpose of the Immigration Committee is to advise the |
| 21 | City about policies and actions that would preserve and promote inclusive policies, equal |
| 22 | opportunity, and equal protection for immigrants and immigrant populations in Santa Fe consistent |
| 23 | with the City's Charter, Section 2.02, "Human and civil rights". |
| 24 | Section 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: The committee shall preform the |
| 25 | following duties and responsibilities: |

| 4 | immigrants and immigrant populations in Santa Fe. |

| 6 | county/state/federal agencies, labor organizations, religious groups, healthcare and |
| 7 | educational institutions, immigrant rights groups, and non-profits, to share resources |
| 8 | and information with one another and with the community, and participate in any other |
| 9 | collaborative activities, as are consistent with the purpose of the committee, as needed, |
| 10 | to support the purposes of the committee. |
| 11 | Section 4. MEMBERSHIP AND OFFICERS: The committee shall consist of nine |
| 12 | representatives residing in the county of Santa Fe and selected from the following areas: human |
| 13 | rights, social services, business community, health care, labor organizations, religious community, |
| 14 | youth services providers, women's advocacy groups, educators, and legal services. The members |
| 15 | shall be appointed by the mayor with the consent of the governing body. The mayor shall appoint |
| 16 | the chairperson and the committee shall designate the vice-chairperson. |
| 17 | Section 5. TERMS: The members shall serve for a period of two years. The |
| 18 | committee members shall serve at the pleasure of the mayor and may be removed at any time, with |
| 19 | or without cause. |
| 20 | Section 6. STAFF LIAISON: The city manager shall designate one or more City staff |
| 21 | members, as appropriate, to serve as liaisons to the committee. |
| 22 | BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the committee shall continue to follow the City's |
| 23 | procedural rules for Committees in carrying out its duties. |
