A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER, WINE, AND CIDER DURING THE SANTA FE PRIDE FESTIVAL ON JUNE 28, 2025, IN A BEER, WINE, AND CIDER GARDEN ADJACENT TO 100 S. LINCOLN AVENUE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 23-6.2(C) SFCC 1987.

WHEREAS, SFCC 1987, Section 23-6.2, governs the consumption of alcohol on City property; and

WHEREAS, for serving alcohol at City properties not specifically mentioned in SFCC 1987, Section 23-6.2(A), the ordinance requires the Governing Body to approve a resolution that specifies the event, date, hours, location, number of expected attendees, type of alcohol to be served, permits, and insurance, at least thirty (30) days prior to the event; and

WHEREAS, Pride is an annual, global celebration of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ+) community, that is held in June every year; and

WHEREAS, 2025 will mark Santa Fe's thirty-second year participating in the annual Pride celebration; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, over eleven thousand (11,000) people participated in the Santa Fe

PRIDE festival; and


WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Human Rights Alliance would like to support a local business by partnering with Kelly’s Liquor Barn to provide beverages for purchase at the Santa Fe PRIDE Festival event; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that alcohol service during the Santa Fe PRIDE Festival is hereby approved according to the following parameters:


Event:	Santa Fe PRIDE Festival
Dates:	June 28, 2025
Hours:	12:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.
Location:	Beer, wine, and cider garden, to be located in the north-bound lane of Lincoln Avenue, adjacent to 100 S. Lincoln Avenue
Number of expected attendees:	12,000
Type of alcohol to be served:	Beer, wine, and cider
Required Permits:	Special Dispenser Permit
Required Insurance:	Liquor Liability and General Liability insurance with limits not less than \$2,000,000, per occurrence and in aggregate, with the City of Santa Fe, its officials, directors, employees, and agents as additional insureds on a primary and noncontributory basis. The Santa Fe Human Rights Alliance shall provide the City with Certificates of Insurance and applicable endorsements evidencing such coverage.


