WHEREAS, she is beloved throughout Santa Fe for her warmth, hospitality, and zest for life, famously saying, "I love the people in Santa Fe! I have so many friends here. I love the beautiful trees and flowers"; and

WHEREAS, we honor and celebrate Mrs. Vitalia Maestas Garcia for her 90 years of love, resilience, and inspiration, and express our deepest gratitude for the joy and strength she brings to the heart of our city.
