**A BILL**

**AMENDING SFCC 1987, SECTION 25-1.8 (A) TO REQUIRE THE CITY OF SANTA FE (“CITY”) TO CONTINUE TO MONITOR THE NATURALLY OCCURRING FLUORIDE LEVELS IN ITS WATER SYSTEM AT REPRESENTATIVE SAMPLE LOCATIONS AND TO END THE REQUIREMENT TO ADD FLUORIDE TO THE SYSTEM.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:**

**Section 1. Section 25-1.8 of SFCC 1987 (being Ord. No. 2003-25, § 32, as amended) is amended to read:**

**25-1.8 Fluoridation of water supply**

A. ~~[The water supply of the city shall be fluoridated by the addition of sufficient fluoride ion to raise the concentration of fluoride ion reaching each customer to an optimal level on one (1) part per million parts of water. The fluoride ion level shall be maintained between a minimum of eight tenths (.8) part per million parts and a maximum of one and two tenths (1.2) parts per million parts of water.]~~

B.] The city shall monitor naturally occurring fluoride ion levels in representative

1 sample locations at least once per month. The water division shall report the results of the monthly  
2 monitoring in its annual water quality report.
