16	Section 1. Amending Section 11-8 of SFCC 1987 (being SFCC 1981, § 9-3-11) to
17	read:
18	11-8 – INVESTMENT OF PUBLIC FUNDS.
19	A. The city shall invest to the fullest extent all available funds, at the highest rate of return,
20	pursuant to Sections 6-10-10 through 6-10-40 NMSA 1978, and state board of finance
21	directives which set forth the interest rate policy on public funds.
22	B. The governing body shall adopt by resolution an investment policy designating as a
23	minimum:
24	(1) An investment fund; and
25	(2) An investment portfolio.
