I humbly submit my name for consideration as an appointee to complete your term as City Councilor for District 2. Throughout my professional career, I have strived to find jobs that are of service to the public and, it was this desire to serve that led me to run in the 2025 General Election.

I learned a great deal during my time campaigning. First and foremost, I learned the importance of listening to people. I was surprised, for instance, to learn that the number one concern of many voters in our district wasn't crime, homelessness, or housing, but rather the lack of basic city services over the past few years. Whether it was potholes or weeds in the park, many of our fellow citizens felt that the city could do better.

I have more than 24 years of government service at both the city and federal level. My first job out of high school was as a Police Service Aide for the Albuquerque Police Department. I then served in the Air Force for eight years. During this time, I worked directly for the Director of Policy for Air Mobility Command, one of the Air Force's two major commands. It was there that I learned how to write and implement policies for large governmental organizations.

I went on to serve as a contractor, first for the Department of Defense supporting the Air Force, and later for the Department of Energy at Los Alamos National Laboratory. I continued to develop my abilities to work as part of a team and also gained experience in the procurement of services and equipment.

I was a political unknown when I announced my campaign last April, but at the end of it all, I received 46% of the vote, placing second out of four candidates with 3000 votes. I also earned numerous endorsements, including The Santa Fe New Mexican and AFSCME. I believe this demonstrates both my commitment to our city and my ability to listen to and represent the concerns of the people of Santa Fe.
