REDISTRICTING

WHAT IS "REDISTRICTING"?

- The adjustment of election district boundaries to account for population shifts
- The way in which we change districts to determine who represents us

WHEN?

- REQUIRED AFTER EACH DECENNIAL CENSUS
 - ADJUSTMENTS BASED ON CURRENT CENSUS DATA
- SANTA FE CITY CHARTER ALLOWS FOR REDISTRICTING MORE THAN ONCE PER DECADE
 - SANTA FE REDISTRICTED IN 2015 AFTER A MAJOR ANNEXATION

IDEAL DISTRICT POPULATION = TOTAL CITY POPULATION / # OF DISTRICTS

ALLOWABLE DEVIATION FROM THE IDEAL POPULATION

CITY COUNCIL DISTRICTS MUST BE "SUBSTANTIALLY EQUAL"

+ 5% FROM THE IDEAL POPULATION OF A DISTRICT (STATE STATUTE)

IDEAL POPULATION: 21,876
+ 5% OF IDEAL POPULATION: 20,783 TO 22,969

COMMUNITIES OF INTEREST

OTHER FACTORS THAT MAY BE CONSIDERED WHEN DRAWING DISTRICTS

• A GROUP/AREA WITH SHARED CHARACTERISTICS:

NEIGHBORHOODS

CULTURAL/LANGUAGE/HISTORICAL TRADITIONS

GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES

LIVED EXPERIENCES

- MAINTAINING CORE OF EXISTING DISTRICTS
- RESPECTING POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS (E.G., AVOID PRECINCT SPLITS)
- TAKING INTO ACCOUNT INCUMBENTS' RESIDENTIAL LOCATION


