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10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **ACCEPTING DONATIONS FROM THE SANTA FE PICKLEBALL CLUB AND THE**
12 **MAMMEL FOUNDATION FOR THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF**
13 **PICKLEBALL COURTS AT FORT MARCY PARK AND DIRECTING THE USE OF**
14 **CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUNDS TO CONSTRUCT SIX ADDITIONAL**
15 **PICKLEBALL COURTS.**

17 **WHEREAS**, the Capital Improvement Project list for the City of Santa Fe (“City”)
18 includes constructing new pickleball courts; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Santa Fe Pickleball Club (“Club”) desires to donate up to \$50,000) and
20 the Mammel Foundation (“Foundation”) desires to donate up to \$50,000, for a total potential
21 donation of \$100,000 (“Donation”) to the City for the design and construction of six additional
22 pickleball courts on City-owned property in a currently undeveloped area at the west side of Fort
23 Marcy Park, south of Murales Road (“Site”); and

24 **WHEREAS**, Club members report the Club raised its portion the Donation through the
25 Club members’ direct fundraising efforts; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the Donation is only intended to fund the design and construction of six
2 courts at the Site (“Limited Purpose”); and

3 **WHEREAS**, the City desires to accept the Donation for the Limited Purpose and to initiate
4 the process for the design and construction of an additional six pickleball courts at the Site.

5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
6 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Governing Body:

- 7 1. Accepts the Donation for the Limited Purposes; and
- 8 2. Directs the City Manager to assemble the appropriate City staff to identify capital
9 improvement funds for the construction of six (6) additional pickleball courts and to
10 commence the construction of the courts as soon as practicable, following standard City
11 procedures and procurement regulations.

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, if the Donation is not fully spent two years from
13 the date the City receives it, the City shall return the unexpended portion of the Donation to the
14 Club and the Foundation in proportions relative to the amount donated by each donor.

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, if the City determines it will not use the Donation
16 for the Limited Purpose, it shall return the funds to Club as soon as practicable.

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that, upon delivery of the donated funds to the City by
18 the Club and the Foundation and, upon the donors’ request, the City Manager shall provide the
19 Club with a written acknowledgement of the receipt of the Donation, specifying the amount
20 received and the terms of the Donation, including the requirement for the return of the Donation if
21 it is not used for the Limited Purpose within two years.
