19	at least thirty (30) days prior to the event; and
20	WHEREAS, the International Folk Art Market ("IFAM") is an annual event featuring
21	artisans from throughout the world; and
22	WHEREAS, IFAM is a significant event benefiting the City of Santa Fe's tourism
23	industry; and
24	WHEREAS, the IFAM was held at the Railyard Park in 2023, was held previously at
25	Milner Plaza, and is planned to be held at the Railyard Park in 2024.

10	Number of expected attendees:	2,000 attendees are expected in the Railyard Park at any

12	Type of alcohol to be served:	Beer and wine.	
13	Required Permits:	Special dispenser permit.	
14	Required Insurance:	Liquor Liability and General Liability insurance with	
15		limits not less than \$2,000,000, per occurrence and in the
