10	A RESOLUTION
11	ADOPTING ANNUAL OPEN MEETINGS ACT NOTICE STANDARDS FOR 2026.
12	
13	WHEREAS, the New Mexico Open Meetings Act ("Open Meetings Act") NMSA 1978
14	§§ $10-15-1$ to -4 , requires that public bodies "determine at least annually in a public meeting what
15	notice for a public meeting is reasonable when applied to that body"; and
16	WHEREAS, the Open Meetings Act applies to the City of Santa Fe's ("City's")
17	Governing Body and the Governing Body's subordinate policymaking bodies; and
18	WHEREAS, the Governing Body desires to comply with the Open Meetings Act's annual
19	public notice requirement by adopting this resolution, establishing reasonable notice standards for
20	the City's policymaking bodies; and
21	WHEREAS, the Governing Body seeks to give annual notice to the public of its
22	determination, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 10-15-1(D), that it adopts an annual regular
23	meeting calendar for the Governing Body's regular meetings for the entire calendar year and
24	provides at least a seventy-two (72) hour notice of the agenda items scheduled for discussion prior
25	to its regular and special meetings; and

WHEREAS, although many of the City's subordinate policy-making bodies' meetings are noticed weeks or months in advance, seventy-two hours notice is also reasonable for noticing the meetings of subordinate policymaking bodies and for posting agendas listing the matters that will be discussed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

- **Section 1.** The Open Meetings Act applies to the City's policymaking bodies.
- **Section 2.** The notice requirements set forth below are hereby adopted.
 - A. The City shall give at least seventy-two (72) hours' notice of all regular and special meetings of the Governing Body and its subordinate policymaking bodies.
 - B. The notice shall include the date, time, place(s) of the planned meeting, and a list of the specific items of business to be discussed or transacted at the meeting or information about how the public may obtain a copy of such an agenda.
 - C. The City shall make the notice available to the public and news media through reasonable means, including posting on the City's website, and providing the notice to broadcast stations licensed by the federal communications commission and newspapers of general circulation that have provided a written request for such notice.
 - D. Agendas shall be posted on the City's website.
- **Section 3.** Regular Meetings of the Governing Body
 - A. Unless otherwise specified, including in subsection B below, regular meetings of the Governing Body shall be held as follows:
 - i. On the 15th of January and last Wednesday of January.
 - ii. The second and last Wednesday of each month after January, other

1	than November and December, when regular meetings will be
2	the second Wednesday but not the last Wednesday.
3	iii. In the City Council Chambers of the municipal building of
4	City, located at 200 Lincoln Avenue, Santa Fe.
5	B. When it is difficult or impossible for members of the Governing Body
6	meet in person, they may participate virtually pursuant to SFCC 1987, Section
7	9.
8	C. To the extent possible, meetings will be broadcast via the City's YouTu
9	channel and other media as available, such as on the radio from KSFR 101.1 F.
10	Section 4. Special Meetings
11	A. The City shall provide a minimum of 72 hours' notice of all spec
12	meetings of the Governing Body and its subordinate policymaking bodies.
13	B. Unless otherwise specified, special meetings are held at the same place
14	regular meetings. The date, time, and place of a special meeting shall appear
15	the agenda and be made available to the public and news media through reasona
16	means including posting on the City's website.
17	C. The agenda shall be posted on the City's website.
18	D. When it is difficult or impossible for members of the Governing Body
19	meet in person, they may participate virtually pursuant to SFCC 1987, Section
20	9.
21	E. To the extent possible, meetings will be broadcast via the City's YouTu
22	channel and other media as available, such as on the radio station KSFR 101.1 F
23	Section 5. Quasi-Judicial Committees and Subordinate Policymaking Bodies
24	A. Every quasi-judicial committee, board, or commission, including but
25	limited to the planning commission, historic design review board, and board

1	adjustment, shall follow the same notice requirements as the Governing Body, and
2	as provided in this resolution and the Open Meetings Act.
3	B. All other policymaking boards, commissions, and committees shall follow
4	the same notice requirements as provided by the Open Meetings Act.
5	Section 6. Emergency Meetings
6	A. Pursuant to its procedural rules, the Governing Body or subordinate
7	policymaking body may call, with, if possible, up to 24 hours' notice, a meeting to
8	consider any matter that, if not addressed immediately, will likely result in injury
9	or damage to persons or property or significant financial loss to the City. When
10	possible, the City will provide 24-hour telephonic notice to all media who normally
11	cover City meetings before the emergency meeting commences.
12	B. The notice for all emergency meetings shall include an agenda for the
13	meeting or information on how the public may obtain a copy of the agenda. Unless
14	there is a State or national emergency already declared for the same reasons, within
15	ten (10) days of taking action on an emergency matter, the City will notify the
16	Attorney General's Office that the emergency meeting took place.
17	Section 7. Term
18	This Resolution shall sunset upon adoption of the 2027 Open Meetings Act Resolution,
19	making it unnecessary to rescind.
