11	AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO APPLY TO THE NEW MEXICO FILM OFFICE TO
12	DESIGNATE THE CITY'S MIDTOWN SITE AS A QUALIFIED PRODUCTION
13	FACILITY.
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15	WHEREAS, according to the Santa Fe Film Office, the film industry in New Mexico
16	supports approximately eight thousand (8,000) jobs statewide, directly and indirectly, including
17	approximately two thousand (2,000) jobs in the Santa Fe region; and
18	WHEREAS, Moviemaker Magazine named the city of Santa Fe "#1 Best Places to Live
19	and Work as a Movie Maker" in all of North America (Cananda, U.S., Mexico) in the "Small Cities"
20	category for 2023 and 2024; and
21	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe ("City") has leased part of the City-owned Midtown Site
22	(1600 S. St. Michael's Drive, Santa Fe, NM), "Garson Studios" for film and television production
23	since 2018; and
24	WHEREAS, leasing Garson Studios provides critical lease income to the City to service
25	debt on the Midtown Site during the Site's repurposing and redevelopment; and

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WHEREAS, currently, Claudio Ruben of Garson Studios Santa Fe, LLC manages film activities at Midtown; and

WHEREAS, the City also licenses film activity in various buildings throughout the Midtown Site outside the Garson Studios; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Film Office ("NMFO") incentivizes local filming to help attract television and film productions to New Mexico and Santa Fe, with all the above-mentioned benefits; and

WHEREAS, according to the NMFO, one of the incentives it offers is an additional 5% tax rebate for filming using any portion of facilities with the designation of "Qualified Production Facility," which is a building, or complex of buildings, building improvements, and associated back-lot facilities in which films are or are intended to be regularly produced and that contain at least one of the following:

- Sound stage with contiguous floor space of at least seven thousand square feet and a ceiling high of no less than eighteen feet; or
- 2) Standing set that includes at least one interior, and at least five exteriors, built or repurposed for film production use on a continual basis and is located on at lease fifty acres of contiguous space designated for film production; and

WHEREAS, the Midtown Site exceeds both of the requirements; and

WHEREAS, the NMFO registering the Midtown Site as a Qualified Production Facility would make production at the Midtown Site more attractive to television and film producers because it would make the producers eligible for an additional 5% tax rebate; and

WHEREAS, while it is being developed, the Midtown Site will provide a new, unique backdrop for movie productions, with construction areas and new and old architecture, all in one place.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
