A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL DURING SITE SANTA FE'S ANNUAL BENEFIT AND CONCERT ON CITY PROPERTY FOR THE YEARS 2023-2027, PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION 23-6.2(C) SFCC 1987.

WHEREAS, SFCC 1987, Section 23-6.2 describes the City's new process for approving the consumption of alcohol on city property; and

WHEREAS, for locations not specifically mentioned in SFCC 1987, Section 23-6.2(A), the ordinance requires the Governing Body approve a resolution that specifies the event, date, hours, location, number of expected attendees, type of alcohol to be served, permits, and insurance, at least thirty days prior to the event; and

WHEREAS, approval for the sale and consumption of alcohol on city property is limited to a single event, unless otherwise stated in the approving resolution; and

WHEREAS, SITE Santa Fe seeks to nurture innovation, discovery, and inspiration through the art of today; and

WHEREAS, SITE Santa Fe was founded in 1995 to establish the first international

1 contemporary art biennial in the United States and is committed to supporting new developments
2 in contemporary art, encouraging artistic exploration, and expanding traditional museum
3 experiences; and

4 **WHEREAS**, since its launch, SITE Santa Fe has presented 11 international biennials, more
5 than 90 contemporary art exhibitions, and work by hundreds of emerging and established artists
6 from around the world and right here in New Mexico; and

7 **WHEREAS**, SITE Santa Fe also presents a wide range of public and educational programs
8 that include conversations with artists and curators, performances, film screenings, concerts, hands-
9 on workshops, and collaborations with dozens of local schools and community organizations; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the building that houses SITE Santa Fe was extensively renovated and
11 expanded in 2016/2017, creating a space that reinvents the institution and brings a distinctive
12 building to Santa Fe's landscape; and

13 **WHEREAS**, SITE Santa Fe requests permission to provide alcohol service for the annual
14 gala limited to wine and beer and adhering to all regulations required in Section 23-6.3 SFCC 1987
15 on one Thursday in June for the years 2023-2027; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the requested dates are specifically: June 22, 2023; June 20, 2024; June 26,
17 2025; June 25, 2026; and June 24, 2027.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
19 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that alcohol service for the following event is hereby approved.

20 Event: SITE Santa Fe's Annual Benefit and Concert
21 Dates: June 22, 2023; June 20, 2024, June 26, 2025; June 25,
22 2026; and June 24, 2027.
23 Hours: 6:00 p.m. – 10:30 p.m.
24 Location: Performance Green at the Railyard Park
