A RESOLUTION

ADOPTING THE 2024-2028 SENIOR INFRASTRUCTURE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PLAN (ICIP) FOR THE DIVISION OF SENIOR SERVICES, COMMUNITY HEALTH AND SAFETY DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico, recognizes that the financing of public capital projects is important in New Mexico and nationally; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to identify financing mechanisms and maximize the use of existing resources; and

WHEREAS, systematic capital improvements planning helps communities define their development needs, establish priorities, and pursue concrete actions and strategies to achieve necessary project development; and

WHEREAS, this process contributes to local and regional efforts in project identification and selection in short and long-range capital planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, the capital outlay projects listed in the attached capital improvements plan are intended to improve seniors' access to various services and programs that the Division of Senior

1 Services provides; and

2 **WHEREAS**, investing in capital outlay projects for seniors is essential to meet the current and
3 future demands of the growing aging population in the City of Santa Fe; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the State of New Mexico, Department of Finance and Administration requires
5 that the City adopt a separate capital improvements plan for Senior Services, in addition to a general
6 ICIP plan, in order to be eligible for certain State and federal funds.

7 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CIY**
8 **OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO** that

9 1. The City of Santa Fe hereby adopts the attached 2024-2028 Senior Infrastructure
10 Capital Improvements Plan for the Division of Senior Services; and

11 2. The Plan is intended to be a working document and is the first of many steps toward
12 improving rational, long-range capital planning and budgeting for New Mexico’s
13 infrastructure.


