B. Promotional recognition of Fire Department Personnel (Fire Chief Erik Litzenberg)

Chief Litzenberg provided the recognition and awards for promotions in the following areas: Training Officer to Medical Officer, Training Captain to Training Officer, Rescue Technician (4). Each fire fighter came before the public safety committee to receive their awards. Recognition of the 29th Recruit Academy to Firefighter I. C. Holiday Enforcement Plans (Deputy Police Chief Dale Lettenberger) It was reported that the 4/10 schedule has been successful which has allowed funding through the overtime budget to staff up during the holidays. Plans will be for enforcement in and around the mall areas from black Friday until January 1st. Santa Fe City Police is working with State Police and Sheriff's Department as well as working with city of Espanola. Extra officers will be added for extra calls of service. The hope is to keep burglaries down through end of year.

Chief Lettenberger provided an update on the STOP program. A new RFP has been issued as the previous was halted in the Finance Committee. Target date for review of RFP's submitted is before end of the year. New companies are being looked at and review of doing in-house is being considered.

 - Certificate of Appreciation-Police recognition: Sergeant Judah Montano Chief Garcia has moved forward to recognize the employee and the family as the families are so supportive of our officers.
 - Lt. Stratton Police Community Relations Recognized Sgt. Montano and described his service saving the life of a very young child at Target who was choking in the arms of her mother. Sgt. Montano was conducting a child ID presentation at Target and recognized that the child was choking; they

immediately called for EMS services and in the interim he was able to resuscitate the child back to breathing. The Public Safety Committee members, Chief Garcia and Fire Chief Litzenberg commended Sgt. Montano for his bravery in assisting this mother and saving the life of this child.

B. Certificate of Appreciation - Family of Blue
Information was provided on how the Family of Blue program came about with the two
young ladies requesting an appointment to volunteer their time and service to assist the
officers in the field. These young ladies, wives of SFPD have provided a service to the
officers. An example was given on how they could support the officers when they are
doing public service assignments, provide them meals, give them water, etc., and doing
community service. The Chief's of the City Police were very supportive of the
presentation by these young ladies who brought the program forward and today paid
recognition for their unselfish commitment to the SFPD officers.

Paula Sena and Tanya Barela were presented Muchas Gracias for their unselfish work and contributions to the City Police. Thank you to the Officers and their wives and families.
