5	AN ORDINANCE
6	AMENDING SUBSECTION 23-6.2 SFCC 1987 TO PERMIT THE SALE AND
7	CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL AT THE RAILYARD PARK FOR THE BIKE AND
8	BREW EVENT.

10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:
11	Section 1. Subsection 23-6.2 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #2012-20, as amended) is
12	amended to read:
13	23-6.2 Permitted Locations for the Sale and Consumption of Alcohol on
14	City Property.
15	The sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages is permitted at the following locations on
16	city property:
17	A. The Santa Fe community convention center and adjacent outdoor spaces under
18	the center's control;
19	B. That area of the Santa Fe municipal airport main terminal building and adjacent
20	areas operated as a restaurant; and
21	C. The Marty Sanchez Links de Santa Fe (golf course).
22	D. The area of the Fort Marcy Ballpark designated for concessions and seating shall
23	be used for the sale and consumption of only beer and only at professional baseball games.
24	(1) A special dispenser permit shall be used to dispense alcohol. The alcohol
25	dispenser shall comply with all state and local laws and regulations for dispensing

1	(2) Any professional baseball league games subject to this section, shall not
2	take precedence over the scheduling of local youth baseball leagues using Fort Marcy
3	Ballpark.
4	E. An area of the Railyard Park, designated as a beer garden and permitted in
5	accordance with all city and state requirements, may be used for the sale and consumption of beer
6	and wine, during the Bike and Brew Festival if a valid permit is acquired from the Santa Fe
7	Railyard Community Corporation. The event sponsor shall comply with the requirements of
8	23-6.3 SFCC 1987, except that the alcohol content, to allow for craft beer, may exceed five
9	percent (5%) alcohol. This section shall be reviewed by the governing body within one (1) year
10	from the date of adoption.
11	F. Buildings owned by another party located on land owned by the city.
12	G. On land or buildings owned by the city for which the city has entered into a lease
13	with another party for six (6) months or more except for the Railyard Park, Plaza and Alameda
14	(as defined in the Deed of Conservation Easement dated October 1, 2004) where alcohol is
15	prohibited, unless specifically permitted under Subsection 23-6.2 SFCC 1987.
16	H. In or on railroad cars located on railroad tracks except as prohibited by state or
17	federal law.
18	All other applicable approvals required by state or city laws and regulations shall be
19	obtained prior to the sale or consumption of alcoholic beverages on the property described in this
20	subsection 23-6.2.
