## CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO ORDINANCE NO. 2015-15

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE CITY OF SANTA FE ALARM SYSTEM ORDINANCE, SECTION 20-5 SFCC 1987 TO CLARIFY CERTAIN PROVISIONS; AMEND THE FINES FOR FALSE ALARMS; AND AMEND LATE REPORTING FEES THAT ARE ASSESSED AGAINST ALARM INSTALLATION COMPANIES AND ALARM MONITORING COMPANIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

Section 1. Section 20-5.6 SFCC 1987 (Ord. #2009-33, §8, as amended) is amended to read:

## 20-5.6 Alarm Registration; Duration and Renewal.

An alarm registration shall expire one (1) year from the date of issuance, and shall be renewed annually by submitting an updated application and a registration renewal fee to the alarm administrator. The alarm administrator shall notify each alarm user of the need to renew their registration within sixty (60) days prior to the expiration of the registration. It is the responsibility of the alarm user to submit an application for renewal prior to the registration expiration date. Failure to renew will be classified as use of a non-registered alarm system. For each alarm occurrence, the fine for a non-registered alarm site, as set forth in subsection 20-5.14 SFCC 1987, shall be assessed. A waiver shall be granted for an assessed fine for an unregistered alarm system, if the registration is completed by the alarm user within ten (10) business days upon notification of the initial fine for an unregistered alarm system. A late fee may be assessed if the renewal is more than thirty (30) days late.
