10	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:		
11	Section 1. A new Section 7-16 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:		
12	7-16 SINGLE-OCCUPANT RESTROOMS.		
13	7-16.1 Definitions.		
14	Gender neutral signage means a sign that indicates a restroom without preference to a		
15	specific gender.		
16	Private or private use restroom means plumbing fixtures in residences and apartments		
17	private bathrooms in hotels and hospitals, and restrooms in commercial establishments where the		
18	fixtures are intended for the use of a family or an individual and are accessible only from a private		
19	room or office.		
20	Single-occupant restroom means a lockable restroom available for an individual for use with		
21	or without assistance.		
22	7-16.2 Applicability.		
23	This section applies to single-occupant restrooms within commercial facilities that are no		
24	private or private use restrooms. This section is an additional requirement to those already required in		
25	the Santa Fe City Code.		

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1	7-16.3	Signage Required.
2	A.	A single-occupant restroom subject to this Section shall have gender-neutral signage.
3	В.	A person with control over a commercial facility with at least one (1) single-occupant
4	restroom shall i	nstall and maintain gender-neutral signage for each single-occupant restroom.
5	7-16.4	Amendment to Section 2902.2 of the International Building Code; Separate
6	Facilities.	
7	2902.2	Separate facilities. Where plumbing fixtures are required, separate facilities shall be
8	provided for ea	ch sex.
9	Except	ions:
10	1.	Separate facilities shall not be required for dwelling units and sleeping units.
11	2.	Separate facilities shall not be required in structures or tenant spaces with a total
12		occupant load, including both employees and customers, of 15 or less.
13	3.	Separate facilities shall not be required in mercantile occupancies in which the
14		maximum occupant load is 50 or less.
15	4.	Single-occupant public or employee restrooms shall not be restricted to use by a
16		specific sex or gender identity by means of signage, design or installation of fixtures.
