No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, except when necessary to avoid 15 conflict with other traffic or in compliance with law or the directions of a police 16 officer or traffic-control device, in any of the following places: 17 (1) on a sidewalk; 18 in front of a public or private driveway; 19 (2) within an intersection; 20 (3) in a marked bicycle lane; **(4)** 21 (5) within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant; 22 (6) on a crosswalk; 23 within twenty (20) feet of a crosswalk at an intersection; **(7)** 24 within thirty (30) feet upon the approach to any flashing beacon, stop 25 (8)

1		sign, or traffic-control signal located at the side of a street;
2	(9)	between a safety zone and the adjacent curb or within thirty (30) feet
3		of points on the curb immediately opposite the end of a safety zone,
4		unless the traffic authority indicates a different length by signs or
5		markings;
6	(10)	within fifty (50) feet of the nearest rail of a railroad crossing;
7	(11)	within twenty (20) feet of the driveway entrance to any fire station
8		and on the side of a street opposite the entrance to any fire station
9		within seventy-five (75) feet of said entrance, when properly
10		signposted;
11	(12)	alongside or opposite any excavation or obstruction when stopping,
12		standing or parking would obstruct traffic;
13	(13)	on the street side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the edge or curb
14		of a street;
15	(14)	upon any bridge or other elevated structure upon a street or within a
16		street tunnel;
17	(15)	at any place where official signs prohibit stopping (66-7-351 NMSA
18		198);
19	(16)	on any railroad track; or
20	(17)	between a curb and sidewalk or between a curb or lateral line of a
21		roadway, and the adjacent property line. (*)
22	B. No person	shall move a vehicle not lawfully under his control into any such
23	prohibited	area or away from a curb such distance as is unlawful. (66-7-351
24	NMSA 19	778)
25	C. The foreg	oing provisions may be modified by the administrator or their[his]

1	designated representative upon the basis of an engineering and traffic	
2	investigation study by the use of appropriate markings, signs or parking meters.
