Gonzales 6 Councilor Chris Rivera Councilor Peter Ives 7 Councilor Ron Trujillo 8 9 10 A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING SANTA FE AS A PURPLE HEART CITY AS PART OF THE 11 NATIONAL CAMPAIGN BY THE MILITARY ORDER OF THE PURPLE HEART OF 12 13 THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA. 14 WHEREAS, the Purple Heart is the oldest military medal currently being awarded by the 15 United States Military Services, originating in 1782 by General George Washington; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Purple Heart was originally known as the Badge of Military merit, and was designed to recognize "instances of unusual Gallantry and Fidelity" by soldiers; and 18 WHEREAS, revival of the Purple Heart award occurred by Executive Order in 1932, at 19 the direction of President Hoover and what was then the United States War Department; and 20 WHEREAS, the Military Order of the Purple Heart of the United States of America was 21 formed in 1932, and subsequently chartered by Congress in 1958, and is composed of recipients 22 23 of the Purple Heart Award for wounds suffered in combat; and 24 WHEREAS, the mission of the Military Order of the Purple Heart is to foster an environment of goodwill among the combat-wounded veteran members and their families, 25

promote patriotism, support legislative initiatives, and most importantly make sure that Americans never forget to recognize the price that servicemen and women have paid for our nation's freedom; and

WHEREAS, the Purple Heart is awarded to soldiers who are wounded or killed at the hands of the enemy while in combat and serving as a member of the United States Military; and

WHEREAS, there are over 1000 Purple Heart cities and counties throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe and surrounding areas has a large concentration of highly decorated military veterans and Purple Heart recipients; and

WHEREAS, residents of the City of Santa Fe have the utmost respect and gratitude to the men and women who have served their community and country selflessly through dedicated service in the Armed Forces.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the City of Santa Fe is hereby designated a Purple Heart City as part of the national campaign by the Military Order of the Purple Heart of the United States of America.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the citizens of the City of Santa Fe are encouraged to show their appreciation for the courage and sacrifices made by Purple Heart recipients in defending our freedoms, and to show them the honor, respect and support they have earned through their service in the Armed Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City of Santa Fe shall work with appropriate State and County agencies to place signage at the entrances to, and other fitting locations around, the City designating the City of Santa Fe as a Purple Heart City.
