11	DIRECTING PUBLIC UTILITIES DEPARTMENT STAFF TO IDENTIFY AND APPLY
12	FOR FEDERAL AND STATE FUNDING SOURCES FOR WATER, WASTEWATER AND
13	OTHER WATER RELATED PROJECTS.
14	
15	WHEREAS, municipal water systems and wastewater systems take significant
16	investments to install, upgrade or replace infrastructure; and
17	WHEREAS, adequate water and wastewater facilities, in addition to protecting public and
18	environmental health, enable communities to grow and attract businesses; and
19	WHEREAS, through the adoption of Resolution No. 2015-111, the Governing Body
20	established certain water project priorities for consideration by the 52nd Legislature, 2nd session,
21	2016; and
22	WHEREAS, there is an ongoing need for the City of Santa Fe to obtain funding for water
23	and wastewater projects.
24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
25	CITY OF SANTA FE that Public Utilities Department staff are directed to:

1	1.	Identify, without limitation, water, wastewater, water conservation, water treatment
2		water recycling, water reuse, water storage, water conveyance, water delivery, flood
3		prevention, watershed restoration, watershed management, and other similar project
4		priorities, and research and identify potential Federal and State funding sources for
5		such projects.
6	2.	Apply for funding and bring specific agreements for such projects back through
7		committee review and approval by the Governing Body.
8	3.	Identify a State Legislative priority list of such projects for presentation to the City's
9		State Legislative Delegation.
10	4.	Submit an application to the New Mexico Water Trust Board, in compliance with
11		New Mexico Water Trust Board policy, for financial assistance from the New
12		Mexico Water Project Fund for all project types eligible for consideration, including
13		but not limited to:
14		a) Water conservation, treatment, recycling, and reuse projects;
15		b) Flood prevention projects;
16		c) Endangered species act (ESA) collaborative projects;
17		d) Water storage, conveyance and delivery projects;
18		e) Watershed restoration and management projects.
