11	AMENDING RESOLUTION 2014-96 TO DIRECT STAFF TO COORDINATE FREE		
12	TRANSPORTATION AND PARKING OPTIONS FOR PATIENTS AND VOLUNTEERS OF		
13	THE MISSION OF MERCY PROGRAM SPONSORED BY THE NEW MEXICO DENTAI		
14	FOUNDATION.

16	WHEREAS, the Governing Body passed Resolution No. 2014-96 on December 10, 2014		
17	that endorsed the efforts of the New Mexico Dental Foundation and their Mission of Mercy program		
18	that provides no-cost dental care to residents of New Mexico; and		
19	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe will host the next Mission of Mercy at the Santa Fe		
20	Community Convention Center on April 8-9, 2016; and		
21	WHEREAS, the Governing Body has authorized the waiver of fees for use of the Santa Fe		
22	Community Convention Center for the Mission of Mercy event; and		
23	WHEREAS, through the adoption of Resolution 2012-89, the Governing Body endorsed the		
24	efforts of the dental community to collaborate with local schools, health providers and state and local		
25	governmental entities to formulate a plan to provide increased services, education and outreach to the		

1	residents of Santa Fe county; and		
2	WHEREAS, there is a great need for dental care in our local community, in particular the		
3	underserved working-poor of Santa Fe; and		
4	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is tasked with representing and addressing the needs of its		
5	residents; and		
6	WHEREAS, the New Mexico Mission of Mercy is a program of the New Mexico Denta		
7	Foundation and the Charitable Arm of the New Mexico Dental Association; and		
8	WHEREAS, the New Mexico Mission of Mercy is a large scale, free two day dental clinic a		
9	which services are provided free of charge for adults and children; and		
10	WHE	REAS, the dental services include cleanings, fillings, root canals, extractions, and	
11	simple prosthetics by approximately 500 volunteer dentists and other dental professionals in addition		
12	to 1000 lay volunteers; and		
13	WHEREAS, New Mexico Mission of Mercy has had four events in Albuquerque, La		
14	Cruces, San Juan County and Central New Mexico at which nearly 5,700 new smiles have bee		
15	created, and over \$3.8 million in free dental treatment have been provided by 4,500 volunteers; and		
16	NOW,	THEREFORE, BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING	
17	BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that staff is directed to:		
18	1.	Coordinate no-cost parking at the Santa Fe Community Convention Center for	
19		doctors and volunteers for both days of the event.	
20	2.	Coordinate transit services from area parking lots and/or bus stops to the Santa Fe	
21		Community Convention Center.	
22	3.	Coordinate free bus service along the Cerillos Road (Route #2) from Santa Fe Place	
23		to the Downtown Transit Center for both days of the event.	
24	4.	Initiate earlier Santa Fe Trails shuttle service starting at 4:30am from Santa Fe Place	
25		for patients both days of the event.	

1	5.	Initiate earlier Santa Fe Pick-Up shuttle service starting at 4:00am for volunteers both
2		days of the event.
3	6.	Allow free parking for volunteers at the Railyard lot and Sandoval lot for both days
4		of the event.
5	7.	Coordinate the bagging of meters on Federal Place and Sheridan Street to be used by
6		patients for both days of the event.
