The governing body, through the adoption of this ordinance, authorizes the 17 B. reallocation of funds from the 2012 parks bond as specified in Section 3 of this ordinance. 18 Section 2. **Legislative Findings** 19 20 A. The 2012 Parks Bond was approved by voters in the amount of \$8,000,000 on March 6, 2012. 21 Many of the projects that were to be funded have been completed. Others В. 22 projects are in progress, or are waiting to be started. 23 A reallocation of bond funds is requested because of changes in priorities and C. 24 needs for the affected city parks. 25
