5 AN ORDINANCE

6 AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE *2008 GENERAL OBLIGATION (GO) BOND*  
7 TO REALLOCATE \$803,000 CURRENTLY DESIGNATED FOR VARIOUS CITY PARK  
8 IMPROVEMENTS TO COMPLETE CERTAIN INCOMPLETE PROJECTS AT  
9 CITY PARKS AND RECREATION FACILITIES AND TO REPLACE THREE FAILING  
10 BRIDGES AT FORT MARCY PARK.

11  
12 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

13 Section 1. Authority

14 A. Section 11-9.1(E) SFCC 1987 requires that any reallocation of proceeds from a  
15 voter-approved general obligation bond that deviates materially from the information provided to  
16 the electorate by the city of Santa Fe shall be voted upon by the governing body through the  
17 adoption of an ordinance.

18 B. The governing body, through the adoption of this ordinance, authorizes the  
19 reallocation of funds from the 2008 parks bond as specified in Section 3 of this ordinance.

20 Section 2. Legislative Findings

21 A. The 2008 General Obligation Bond was approved by voters in the amount of  
22 \$30,300,000 on March 4, 2008.

23 B. Many of the projects that were to be funded by the bond have been completed,  
24 while others are in progress or waiting to be started pending reallocation of unspent funds.

25 C. A reallocation of bond funds is requested to address certain safety concerns and

1 to reflect changes in priorities for city parks.

2 **Section 3. Reallocation**

3 A. The parks and recreation department is recommending the closing/completion of  
4 the following projects from the current funding list:






