1. CALL TO ORDER

The Santa Fe Regional Juvenile Justice Board was called to order at 5:20 p.m. by Sam Jackson, Chair. A quorum was not established.

3. INTRODUCTIONS OF MEMBERS AND GUESTS

Introductions were made by those present.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF JUNE 23, 2016

MOTION: This item could not be approved due to a lack of quorum.

6. FINANCIAL REPORT

A.) Budget- Detailed Budget and Financial Report Final FY 15/16

Mr. DeMella presented his detailed budget and financial report. (See Exhibit A) Mr. DeMella explained the amount of \$20,000 that will be returned from the Day Reporting Program. This is the largest amount that has been returned.

Mr. DeMella explained CYFD had to reconfigure the matched funds for every program. Mr. DeMella passed around a copy of the new invoicing process to demonstrate to the Board the new requirements. They are more detailed and difficult. Some programs cannot fit their data into the new fields.

Ms. Romero discussed the contract between the City and CYFD. She is frustrated with the delay in payment once again. Mr. DeMella explained he sent in the paperwork on July 8th and was told a letter must be signed by the Secretary of CYFD. The last letter on file was to be in good standing until 2018, however they are requesting an updated letter.

A brief discussion was held about the training and the requirements that CYFD has now. Mr. Lovato discussed the process in which that data is brought by the programs to be entered by the City Liaison and passed along for payment.

Mr. Lovato would like to see the matter resolved so that Ms. Romero can be paid. Mr. DeMella will have an answer by tomorrow if the letter was signed the invoice will go through.

Chair Jackson clarified the two issued that were discussed. The issue with ICM's billing in which Mr. DeMella explained he will follow up with it. The other issue is the fields and data that are now being required by CYFD, some programs will not be able to serve and report that data.

Chair Jackson asked Mr. DeMella to report to the Board when the letter gets signed. Ms. Romero expressed her frustration. She discussed her concern with the new unit billing. Ms. Romero explained she serves 10 units because they need it and doesn't include some services or hours. She used to bill by the hour now that has changed.

Chair Jackson states he wants Ms. Romero's invoice to be paid and keep it routine so there are no further issues. Mr. Lovato discussed the previous idea of creating a matrix. Judge Sommer explained to Ms. Romero that she will run out of the allowed budget quickly if she doesn't manage the services correctly or break it down. It was decided that Mr. Lovato, Mr. DeMella and Ms. Romero will meet to discuss and try to resolve the issues.

Chair Jackson would appreciate resolving the delay, every meeting there is discussion of delay in payment to a program.

B.) Approve Financial Report

MOTION: This item could not be approved due to a lack of quorum.

8. MATTERS FROM THE BOARD

Program Committee-Re Engage Specialist

Mr. Lovato reported the program committee met to discuss the Re Engage matter. The amount agreed upon was \$18,000 for Communities in Schools (CIS) and \$30,000 for Re Engage. Somewhere along the process the amounts were switched and submitted incorrectly. Mr. Lovato states the program cannot run on \$18,000. He met with Dr. Boyd who stated the SFPS could match \$5,000, however a week later he resigned from his position.

Mr. Lovato explained CIS won't do it for \$18,000 if there is any way to increase the amount they may consider it. If not, they will have to scour and look for another agent. Another option would be to wait until half way through the next year then present it to JJAC and request more funds.

Ms. Gonzales explained that Restorative Justice cannot comply with the data requests and are out. Perhaps their amount can be applied to the program.

A brief discussion was held about the options, it was decided to discuss at the next meeting.

Retreat for FY 16/17

A discussion was held about the provider meeting with the Children and Youth Commission on August 29th or 30th. Ms. Pathak recalled that it was decided two members would attend the morning session.

A discussion was held about selecting a date for the retreat for September and possibly a weekend since the weeks seem to be full for the Board. Mr. DeMella will email dates to the Board and it can be decided by all.

A brief discussion was held about holding an Executive Session during the retreat. It was decided Mr. DeMella will contact the City Clerk and the City Attorney to clarify.

Update on upcoming programs

Mr. DeMella announced the Dining Hub will open on August 29th at Zona del Sol, it must be approved by City Council.

A discussion was held about the tutoring program at the Teen Resource Center at the Monica Roybal Center. A discussion was held about the hours of operation and the youth that will get serviced and the absence in school. This matter will be discussed further at the next meeting.

There were no matters from members of the public.

There being no further business to come before the Santa Fe Regional Juvenile Justice Board, the meeting was adjourned at 6:07 p.m.
