Ives 7 8 9 10 A RESOLUTION 11 AUTHORIZING MOBILE VEHICLE VENDORS WITHIN THE CANYON ROAD PERIPHERY AREA AT SPECIFIC LOCATIONS, PURSUANT TO THE VEHICLE 12 13 **VENDOR ORDINANCE, 18-8.9 SFCC 1987.** 14 15 WHEREAS, on May 13, 2015, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2015-13 which established the Vehicle Vendor Ordinance, 18-8.9 SFCC 1987; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Vehicle Vendor Ordinance prohibits vehicle vendors within the Plaza 18 Periphery Area, prohibits mobile vehicle vendors from parking for more than three (3) hours at 19 any location, and prohibits mobile vehicle vendors from parking within one hundred fifty (150) 20 feet of the street-level entrance to any restaurant, unless such activities are authorized by a 21 resolution of the Governing Body; and 22 WHEREAS, on May 27, 2015 the Governing Body, in accordance with the Vehicle 23 Vendor Ordinance, adopted Resolution No. 2015-55 which authorized mobile vehicle vendors to operate at three (3) specific locations within the Plaza Periphery Area at specific times of day; 24 25 and

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2016 the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2016-32 which prohibits mobile vehicle vendors from operating on public or private streets within the Canyon Road Periphery Area as defined in said ordinance, unless authorized by a resolution of the governing body; and

WHEREAS, in addition to those areas previously authorized for mobile vehicle vendors by Resolution No. 2015-55, the Governing Body now desires to authorize mobile vehicle vendors at specific locations on public streets within the Canyon Road Periphery Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that, pursuant to the provisions of 18-8.9(C)(7), effective August 1, 2016 mobile vehicle vendors are authorized within the Canyon Road Periphery Area at the following locations and at the following times:

Locations: Two (2) spaces on Canyon Road as identified on the "CANYON ROAD PERIPHERY AREA – MOBILE VEHICLE VENDOR MAP" below.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that:

- (1) City staff shall install a sign at the western end of Canyon Road as notification that mobile vehicle vendors are prohibited within the Canyon Road Periphery Area except at posted locations; and
- (2) City staff shall install parking signs at the locations identified by this resolution.

 The signs shall state that parking is reserved for mobile vehicle vendors at these locations; and
- (3) Mobile vehicle vendors parked at these locations shall remain in compliance with the Vehicle Vendor Ordinance at all times; and
- (4) Licensed mobile vehicle vendors shall pay an annual "Supplemental Periphery Fee" of \$150 in addition to the vehicle vendor license fee to vend in any of the authorized locations within the Plaza Periphery Area or the Canyon Road Periphery Area; and
 - (5) The city manager is authorized to adopt administrative procedures for the

management and enforcement of the use of the above locations should the need arise.
