8	GROSS RECEIPTS TAX FOR SUPPORT SERVICES FOR THE RESIDENTS OF THE
9	CITY OF SANTA FE.
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11	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:
12	Section 1. A new Subsection 18-19 SFCC 1987 is ordained to read:
13	18-19 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FUND
14	18-19.1 Dedication.
15	A. When the annual budget is prepared, city staff shall include an amount of the
16	general fund equal to two percent (2%) of the city's share of the state gross receipts tax, which
17	shall be allocated annually to the health and human services fund.
18	B. The health and human services fund will provide and maintain a safety net of
19	services to help meet the essential health and human services needs of the residents of Santa Fe to
20	include improving access to:
21	(1) primary health care;
22	(2) basic material goods, services, food and shelter; and
23	(3) behavioral health services to include mental health, substance abuse, and
24	recovery support services.
2 5	C The fund shall be used to support community programs that align their agency's

1	programs and services outcomes for participants ages 18 or above to the priority outcomes, as
2	identified by the human services committee to include, but not limited to:
3	(1) adult health and behavioral health;
4	(2) community safety; and
5	(3) social justice and quality of life.
6	The priority outcomes will be maintained, updated and/or revised during the
7	annual strategic planning session in accordance with a local, state and national best
8	practice standards and data-driven outcomes.
9	D. All requests for the use of the health and human services fund shall be reviewed
10	by the human services committee, whose purpose is to understand the community needs and
11	support services that help meet the essential health and human services needs of the residents of
12	Santa Fe.
13	E. The health and human services fund is limited to non-city programs.
14	F. Applicants for the health and human services fund shall be limited to to nonprofit
15	organizations that have been granted and currently hold tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3)
16	of the Internal Revenue Code.
