10	A RESOLUTION
11	DECLARING THE ELIGIBILITY AND INTENT OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE TO
12	SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF
13	TRANSPORTATION FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2018 SECTION 5310 PROGRAM
14	FUNDS FOR ENHANCED MOBILITY OF SENIORS AND INDIVIDUALS WITH
15	DISABILITIES PROGRAM.

17	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe, New Mexico has the legal authority to apply for, receive
18	and administer federal funds; and,
19	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe is submitting an application for Federal Fiscal Year 2018
20	(FFY18) Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities program funds
21	for an amount up to \$360,000, as set forth by the Federal legislation, Fixing America's Surface
22	Transportation Act (FAST Act); and,
23	WHEREAS, the vehicle procurement named in the Section 5310 application is an eligible
24	project under FAST Act; and,
25	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe acknowledges availability of the required local match of 20

percent; and

WHEREAS, when purchasing capital using a state approved price agreement, the City of Santa Fe will make a check to the awarded vendor for the 20 percent local match and send the check to the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) Transit and Rail Division; and, at delivery, the check will be given to the vendor and NMDOT will be billed for the difference; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe agrees to pay any costs that exceed the project amount if the application is selected for funding; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe agrees to maintain all capital acquired with Section 5310 funds for the useable life of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO that:

- 1. The City of Santa Fe authorizes the City Manager to submit an application for FFY18 Section 5310 funds for an amount up to \$360,000 to NMDOT on behalf of the residents of the city of Santa Fe.
- 2. The City of Santa Fe authorizes the use of the ¼ cent Gross Receipts Tax dedicated to the Transit Division by Ordinance 2016-5 for the required 20 percent local match if the grant is awarded.
- 3. The City of Santa Fe authorizes the City Manager to enter into a Cooperative Project Agreement with the NMDOT for Section 5310 projects using these funds as set forth by FAST Act on behalf of the residents of City of Santa Fe if the grant is awarded. The City Manager is also authorized to submit additional information as may be required and act as the official representative of the City of Santa Fe in this and subsequent related activities.
- **4.** That the City of Santa Fe assures the NMDOT that if Section 5310 funds are awarded, sufficient funding for the local match is available; a check to the awarded vendor for the local match will be sent to NMDOT; and that any costs exceeding the award amount will be paid for by City of Santa Fe.

1	5. That the City of Santa Fe assures the NMDOT that if awarded Section 5310 funds,
2	sufficient funding for the operation and maintenance of the Section 5310 capital will be available for
3	the life of the project.
4	6. That the City of Santa Fe assures the NMDOT that the City of Santa Fe is willing and able
5	to administer all activities associated with the proposed project.
