Maestas 7 8 9 **A RESOLUTION** 10 DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO DEVELOP A PLAN TO IDENTIFY, LOCATE 11 AND FUND THE CONSTRUCTION OF PUBLIC RESTROOMS IN THE HISTORIC 12 CORE OF SANTA FE; IDENTIFY OTHER AREAS THAT WOULD BENEFIT FROM 13 PUBLIC RESTROOMS; IDENTIFY ANY POTENTIAL FINANCIAL INCENTIVES FOR 14 BUSINESSES WHO MAKE THEIR RESTROOMS AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC; 15 AND REPORT BACK TO THE GOVERNING BODY WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF 16 17 ADOPTION OF THIS RESOLUTION. 18 WHEREAS, the historic downtown area of the City of Santa Fe has limited public 19 restrooms available for tourists and residents; and 20 WHEREAS, the lack of sufficient public restrooms has been the subject of complaints 21 from visitors and residents who support the Santa Fe economy through hotel stays, dining and 22 23 shopping throughout the City; and WHEREAS, the downtown area would be much more welcoming to visitors and 24 residents if public restrooms were available for use, allowing residents and visitors to spend more

time in the area, providing a boost to our tax base; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 2014-49 the Governing Body expressed its desire to bring more people to the downtown plaza to increase a sense of community, and provide economic benefits to downtown area merchants and vendors; and

WHEREAS, the lack of bathrooms in the downtown area has required local businesses to provide bathrooms, incurring increased costs for utilities and maintenance, all due to a lack of public restrooms in the area; and

WHEREAS, attempts in the past to make restrooms available to the public have ultimately proved unsuccessful; and

WHEREAS, the City can benefit from looking to other cities in how they have dealt with the issue of public restrooms in the heavily trafficked areas of their cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE that the City Manager is directed to propose a plan to identify locations for, and a plan to fund, construction of public restrooms in the historic core of Santa Fe, and to work with local businesses to make restroom facilities more accessible to the public.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager shall identify other such area that would benefit from the presence of public restrooms, including the Sheridan Street transportation hub.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager shall identify any potential financial incentives for businesses who make their restrooms available to the public.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager shall report back to the Governing Body within six months of adoption of this resolution regarding the location and funding of public restrooms.
