11	TO ACCEPT THE DONATION OF A PREFABRICATED BUILDING FOR CITY
12	OWNERSHIP.

14	WHEREAS, Faceless Man, LLC desires to donate a building to the city for ownership by the
15	city and to incur the expense of moving the building to a city-designated city property; and
16	WHEREAS, the building is currently located at 313-B Camino Alire and is a one-story,
17	prefabricated metal building, approximately 895 square-feet in size, and has been inspected by the
18	city's Facilities Maintenance Division and determined to be in good and serviceable condition; and
19	WHEREAS, the city's Asset Development Office has identified several potential uses for the
20	donated building; and
21	WHEREAS, the city desires to accept the donation of the building and its relocation costs.
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
23	CITY OF SANTA FE that the Governing Body:
24	1. Accepts the donation of the building and the offer to relocate the building from its
25	current location to a designated city property at his expense; and

1 2. Directs city staff to work with Faceless Man, LLC's representatives and contractors 2 to accomplish the relocation; and 3 3.
