5 AN ORDINANCE

6 AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2016-22 FROM THE 2008 GENERAL OBLIGATION
7 (GO) BOND FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVISING THE REALLOCATION OF FUNDS
8 DESIGNATED FOR VARIOUS CITY PARK IMPROVEMENTS TO RECONCILE
9 PROJECTS.

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE:

12 Section 1. Authority.

13 A. Section 11-9.1(E) SFCC 1987 requires that any reallocation of proceeds from a
14 voter-approved general obligation bond that deviates materially from the information provided to
15 the electorate by the city of Santa Fe shall be voted upon by the governing body through the
16 adoption of an ordinance.

17 B. The governing body, through the adoption of this ordinance, authorizes the
18 reallocation of funds from the 2008 parks bond as specified in Section 3 of this ordinance.

19 Section 2. Legislative Findings.

20 A. The 2008 General Obligation Bond was approved by voters in the amount of
21 \$30,300,000 on March 4, 2008.

22 B. Many of the projects that were to be funded by the bond have been completed.

23 C. A reallocation of bond funds is requested to address certain safety concerns and
24 to reconcile the 2008 General Obligation (GO) Bond monies allocated for various park projects.


