| 21 | Fe City Council took action and provided funds to rehabilitate the site and the building in |
| 22 | accordance with their responsibility to maintain City-owned historic structures; and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, the rehabilitated historic building and surrounding park lands are a public |
| 24 | resource both for Santa Fe residents and visitors from throughout the United States and numerous |
| 25 | foreign countries and provides a community center for and the centerpiece for interpretation of |
