21	6-17.3 Membership; Terms.		
22	A. Membership. The city economic development advisory committee shall be		
23	composed of ten (10) members residing in the city of Santa Fe and qualified by training,		
24	experience, and ability to exercise sound and practical judgment regarding those responsibilities		
25	and duties of the committee. The members shall be appointed by the mayor with the advice and

consent of a majority vote of all the members of the governing body. The members shall include one (1) member of the governing body; and nine (9) other members representing a broad range of business interests, including small and large businesses, within the city including, but not limited to: arts and culture industries; development, design, and construction; hospitality; technology; retail trade and services; workforce development representatives; and healthcare. The member[s] of the governing body shall serve as chairperson. The chairperson shall appoint a vice chairperson. A quorum shall be at least six (6) members. Members shall serve without compensation.

B. Terms. Of the initial appointments, five (5) of the members shall be appointed for one (1) year terms and five (5) shall be appointed for two (2) year terms. Subsequent terms shall be for two (2) years to maintain staggering of terms. There shall be no limitation to the number of consecutive terms a member may serve. Failing to attend three (3) consecutive regular meetings or failing to attend thirty-three percent (33%) or more of the regular meetings in any year shall constitute an automatic tender of resignation by such member, which the governing body may accept or reject at its discretion. Vacancies, other than by expiration of terms, shall be filled for the unexpired term in the same manner as original appointments.

Section 3. Section 6-17 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #2005-5, § 6) is hereby repealed:

6-17.5 Reserved.

Section 4. Subsection 6-17.6 SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #2008-16, § 3) is hereby repealed:

6-17.6 Economic Development Review Subcommittee.

A. The economic development review subcommittee shall review and make recommendations to the economic development advisory committee on applications for the following:

- (1) Assistance for economic development projects; and
- (2) Industrial revenue bonds (IRB's) as set forth in Resolution No. 1995-83 as may be amended.
- B. The economic development review subcommittee shall be composed of five (5) members residing in the county and qualified by training, experience, and ability to exercise sound and practical judgment. Two (2) members shall be members of the economic development advisory committee and two (2) members shall be from the business community. The members shall be appointed by the mayor with the advice and consent of a majority vote of all the members of the city council. The mayor shall designate a member of the governing body to serve as chairperson. The chairperson shall designate a_vice-chairperson from among the subcommittee members. All subcommittee members may be removed from the subcommittee by the mayor with or without cause.
- C. Of the members appointed initially to the subcommittee, two (2) shall have one (1) year terms and all others shall have two (2) year terms. Each subsequent term of a member shall be for two (2) years to maintain the original staggering of terms of membership. There shall be no limitation of the number of consecutive terms a member may serve on the economic development review subcommittee.
- D. The subcommittee shall meet as needed and shall conduct all meetings in accordance with adopted city policy and procedures. At least five (5) days prior to the meeting, staff shall post the tentative meeting agenda in city hall as well as on the city's website. The subcommittee shall keep minutes of its proceedings, showing the vote of each member on each question, or indicating absence or failure to vote and shall keep records of its review and official actions, all of which shall be filed in the city clerk's office.
