| 14 | A. A dedicated public campaign finance fund ("the fund") is established to be | | |
| 15 | administered by the city clerk for the purpose of providing public financing for the election | | |
| 16 | campaigns of participating candidates. Monies in the fund and disbursed from the fund to | | |
| 17 | participating candidates are public monies entrusted to the candidates to be used solely for the | | |
