11	IN SUPPORT OF THE MAYORS FOR NET NEUTRALITY INITIATIVE.

13	WHEREAS, network neutrality is the principle that all Internet traffic should be treated
14	equally. Internet traffic includes all of the different messages, files and data sent over the Internet,
15	including, for example, emails, digital audio files, digital video files; and
16	WHEREAS, on December 14, 2017 the Federal Communications Commission launched
17	the framework for transparency requirements that would empower government oversight of
18	broadband providers' conduct; and
19	WHEREAS, Mayors in other cities (New York, Austin, Portland, San Antonio, Kansas
20	City, San Francisco, Baltimore, Putnam, Madison, San Jose, Minneapolis and Santa Cruz among
21	others) have signed the pledge for net neutrality and are urging other Mayors to sign the pledge
22	and commit to defending net neutrality in their cities and towns; and
23	WHEREAS, the City of Santa Fe prides itself as community that welcomes all walks of
24	life to visit, live, and conduct business; and
25	WHEREAS, it is important for the City of Santa Fe to advocate for the rights of its

residents and those who visit Santa Fe to have a free and open internet without Federal
 Government restrictions to benefit educational initiatives, families, and businesses that are, and
 want to become, part of a thriving Santa Fe community; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body believes that no one should own the internet and that
the City of Santa Fe will advocate for keeping broadband and fiber networks throughout the City
neutral to ensure that our residents and our economy provide the basis for being a user-friendly,
sustainable and ultimately the best place to live, work and raise a family.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
9 CITY OF SANTA FE that the Governing Body supports the Mayors for Net Neutrality pledge
10 and supports the signing of the pledge by the Mayor on behalf of the Governing Body.
