11 REGARDING RESOLUTION 2017-77, THE MUNICIPAL DRUG STRATEGY TASK
12 FORCE, TO EXTEND THE DURATION OF THE TASK FORCE FOR EIGHT MONTHS
13 FROM THE DATE OF APPOINTMENT OF A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS OF THE
14 TASK FORCE.

16 WHEREAS, Resolution 2017-77 was adopted on October 25th, 2017 that created a
17 Municipal Drug Strategy Task Force to explore and recommend long-term solutions in a
18 Community Strategic Plan for addressing issues arising from persons struggling with problematic
19 drug and alcohol use; and

20 WHEREAS, the Task Force consists of twenty members appointed by the mayor with
21 the approval of the Governing Body; and

22 WHEREAS, transition in the administration of the City of Santa Fe slowed full
23 appointment of the Task Force, delaying the work of the Task Force; and

24 WHEREAS, Resolution 2017-77 specified that the Task Force should conclude its work
25 not more than eight months from the adoption of the initial Resolution, a time frame that has

1 since lapsed; and

2 **WHEREAS**, Resolution 2017-77 stated that the Governing Body may further extend the
3 work of the Task Force if such extension is needed.


4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
5 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the Municipal Drug Strategy (MDS) Task Force is hereby granted an
6 extension to complete the duties specified in Resolution 2017-77 of eight months from the date of
