INTRODUCTION OF BOARD MEMBERS AND GUESTS

Victor Vigil introduced Avi Hope, a newly appointed Board Member. He is a student at Academy for Technology and the Classics. He is a freshmen.

He noted that Triana Reed is also a new Board Member. She is a student at the Institute of American Indian Arts.

He said there are still three vacancies on the Board to fill. He asked everyone to introduce themselves.

Sydney Manningham is a student at Santa Fe Prep School and is interested in serving on MYAB. Victor Vigil asked her to submit a letter of interest and a resume.

Jennifer Barreto introduced herself. She is an AmeriCorps VISTA Member.

Approval of the Minutes of the May 17, 2018 meeting; June 28, 2018 meeting and August 23, 2018 meeting was not made due to the lack of a quorum.

DISCUSSION/APPROVAL:

A. Direction from MYAB

Victor Vigil said they would like to know what direction the Board wants to go and what things does the Board want to work on. He said the City has a new Mayor and they would like to invite him to a future meeting and get his vision.

Chair Martinez said now that the Board is getting new members, she would suggest that they review the Youth Summit report because she knows there were a lot of ideas that the Board wanted to work on. She asked the Board if they had anything to add, but there were no comments.

She said she remembers the things that were important to youth were: youth homelessness; food; jobs for teens; things to do for teens, etc.

She noted that a student/junior from Santa Fe Prep School (Emma Lawrence) will be meeting with the Mayor on Monday to talk about teens.

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Chair Martinez said she talked with Superintendent Garcia and they have a meeting on Monday at 5:00 p.m. She called Superintendent Garcia to see if she could help recruit youth for the Board. She may also be able to reach out to the youth and report on what the Mayor's Youth Advisory Board is doing; and get their ideas. Also, Superintendent Garcia is willing to help the Board focus on the underserved or under-represented youth.

Victor Vigil asked if anyone has heard what other youth want to see done in the City, and do they have any ideas or suggestions.

There were no comments.

Victor Vigil gave the members homework for the next meeting. He asked the members present to ask the teens and/or friends what they would like to see done – what do they want the Mayor's Youth Advisory Board to do.

B. Discuss Vision and Mission Statement for MYAB

Victor Vigil said the Board needs to work on the Vision and Mission Statement. This will be on the agenda for the next meeting.

C. Recruitment for MYAB

Victor Vigil asked what could be done further to recruit members for the Board.

Chair Martinez said the Board talked last time about putting it in the newspaper, and possibly asking the Superintendent to make an announcement about the Board at the schools. She said she could ask her to do this when she meets with her next week. She can also ask her about doing some kind of credit for students who serve on the Board. This could be an incentive for the youth to serve on the Board.

She asked Victor Vigil if Edith Martinez had put the vacancies on the city's website.

Victor Vigil said he thinks she did, but he will double check with her.

Jennifer Barreto asked if this would be an extracurricular credit or a college credit. She asked the Board what they had in mind.

Chair Martinez said they do not know. They need to talk to the Superintendent about that and what the schools will offer and accept.




