11 **AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2015-18, REGARDING THE DUTIES AND**
12 **RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE VETERANS' ADVISORY BOARD; AUTHORIZING THE**
13 **USE OF EXISTING FUNDS TO EDUCATE RESIDENTS AND PROMOTE THE**
14 **OPTION FOR A VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION TO THE NEW MEXICO**
15 **VETERANS' STATE CEMETERY FUND FROM A TAX REFUND ON FORM NMPIT-1.**

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17 **WHEREAS**, on February 11, 2015 the Governing Body adopted Resolution No. 2015-18
18 establishing the Veterans' Advisory Board responsible for making recommendations to the
19 Governing Body pertaining to strategies and solutions to address the needs of local veterans; and

20 **WHEREAS**, in 1987 the New Mexico Legislature passed a law creating the New Mexico
21 Veterans' State Cemetery Fund allowing taxpayers the option to contribute a portion of their
22 Personal Income Tax Refund to this fund; and

23 **WHEREAS**, under Duties and Responsibilities of the Veterans' Advisory Board, the
24 Board can make recommendations for the use of funds in accordance with the state law and
25 limited to veteran programs.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
2 CITY OF SANTA FE that the Duties and Responsibilities of the Veterans' Advisory Board are
3 hereby amended as follows:

4 Section 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:


5 A. Make recommendations for the use of funds received from the New Mexico
6 Department of Veterans' Services, in accordance with state law and the New Mexico Veterans'
7 National Cemetery Fund, for veteran programs, pursuant to City of Santa Fe Resolution No.
8 2013-2, including promoting and educating taxpayers about the option to voluntarily contribute to
9 the Fund on NMPIT-1 New Mexico Personal Income Tax Form, line 40.


