11	AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER, CIDER AND WINE AT
12	THE SANTA FE RAILYARD PARK DURING THE SANTA FE INSTITUTE'S
13	INTERPLANETARY FESTIVAL ON JUNE 14-16, 2019, PURSUANT TO SECTION
14	23.6.2(B) SFCC 1987.

16	WHEREAS, the Governing Body adopted Ordinance No. 2017-3 on March 8, 2017 that
17	created a new process for approving the sale and consumption of alcohol on city property; and
18	WHEREAS, for locations not specifically mentioned in Section 23-6.2(A) SFCC 1987,
19	the approval by the Governing Body of a resolution that specifies the event, date, hours, location,
20	number of expected attendees, type of alcohol to be served, and require permits is requested 60
21	days prior to the event; and
22	WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Institute's InterPlanetary Festival was held in June 2017 in the
23	Santa Fe Railyard Plaza and Farmers' Market Pavilion; and
24	WHEREAS, The Santa Fe Institute desires to hold this year's InterPlanetary Festival at
25	the Santa Fe Railyard Park, so as to be able to host this event over the course of a weekend to

1	encourage greater attendance; and
2	WHEREAS, the Railyard Park is a City of Santa Fe Park at which alcohol is not usually
3	served; and
4	WHEREAS, at the last InterPlanetary Festival, the Santa Fe Institute rented the venue
5	space of the Farmer's Market Pavilion, and partnered with Second Street Brewing and Walter
6	Burke Catering to provide a bar for adults to enjoy during and after the festival's programming
7	over the course of two full days; and
8	WHEREAS, alcohol service provided by Second Street Brewery and Sierra Blanca
9	Brewery for this year's event would adhere to all regulations required in Section 23-6.3 SFCC
10	1987; and
11	WHEREAS, the Santa Fe Institute's InterPlanetary Festival hopes to attract an
12	increasing number of out-of-city and out-of-state researchers, tech investors, filmmakers, artists,
13	musicians, families, and science enthusiasts to participate in the festival, and thereby demonstrate
14	to the rest of the nation the growing interest in, and commitment to, humanity's future on earth
15	and beyond, fostered by space-forward organizations in Northern New Mexico.
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
17	CITY OF SANTA FE that alcohol service during the Santa Fe Institute's InterPlanetary Festival
18	is hereby approved.
