10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **APPROVING THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION PLAN FOR BANNERS**
12 **COMMEMORATING VETERANS ALONG THE CERRILLOS ROAD CORRIDOR**
13 **BETWEEN I-25 AND RODEO ROAD.**

15 **WHEREAS**, Santa Fe City Code Section 14-8.10 allows for the installation of banners
16 erected by the City of Santa Fe ("City") or its permittee if approved by the Governing Body via
17 Resolution; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Resolution regarding installation of banners must specify dates of
19 display, location, number, design approval process, installation, maintenance, and cost allocation;
20 and

21 **WHEREAS**, the banners are intended to commemorate the lives of those local veterans
22 who are serving, have served, or been honorably discharged from the United States Military; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the banners are intended to draw attention to Memorial Day and Veterans
24 Day which are among the most respected of our country's national holidays; and

25 **WHEREAS**, in order to allow banners along the Cerrillos Road corridor, the City or its

1 designee must install sign support structures to hang the banners.

2 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
3 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the design and installation plan for banners along Cerrillos Road
4 provided below, is hereby approved:

5 Dates: The banners may be displayed from May 20, 2019 to
6 November 18, 2019.

7 Location: The banners may be displayed on sign support structures
8 to be installed along Cerrillos Road between I-25 and
9 Rodeo Road.

10 Number: Twenty (20) total banners may be displayed.

11 Design Approval Process: The design of the banners has been approved by the
12 Land Use Director as conforming to all applicable
13 requirements and restrictions.

14 Installation: The Public Works Department will install all sign
15 support structures and banners associated with this
16 request.

17 Maintenance: Banners that become damaged, defaced, or are in any
18 form of disrepair shall be replaced immediately at the
19 expense of the American Legion Post 12. The City
20 reserves the right to remove any banners the City deem
21 in disrepair prior to their scheduled removal date.

22 Cost Allocation: The American Legion Post 12 shall be responsible for all
23 costs associated with purchasing the sign support
24 structures and banners. The Public Works Department
25 shall be responsible for all costs associated with

1 installing the sign support structures and banners, and
2 removal of the banners on their scheduled removal date.

3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the prior to installation, the American Legion Post
4 12 shall secure approval from the New Mexico Department of Transportation for the display of
5 the banners in the Cerrillos Road right-of-way.


6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall become effective upon the


