A RESOLUTION

**APPROVING THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION PLAN FOR THIRTY ADDITIONAL
BANNERS COMMEMORATING VETERANS ALONG THE CERRILLOS ROAD
CORRIDOR BETWEEN I-25 AND RODEO ROAD.**

WHEREAS, Santa Fe City Code Section 14-8.10 allows for the installation of banners erected by the City of Santa Fe (“City”) or its permittee if approved by the Governing Body via Resolution; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 14-8.10 the Resolution regarding installation of banners must specify dates of display, location, number, design approval process, installation, maintenance, and cost allocation; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body adopted Resolution 2019-23 which permitted the installation of twenty (20) banners along the Cerrillos Road corridor between I-25 and Rodeo Road; and

WHEREAS, the community reacted positively to the display of the banners and there is demand for thirty (30) additional banners to commemorate other Santa Fe veterans; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the banners are intended to commemorate the lives of those local veterans
2 who are serving, have served, or been honorably discharged from the Armed Forces; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the banners are intended to draw attention to Memorial Day and Veterans
4 Day, which are among the most respected of the United States' national holidays; and

5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
6 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that the design and installation plan for thirty (30) additional banners
7 along Cerrillos Road provided below is hereby approved:

8 **Dates:** The banners may be displayed from August 15, 2019 to
9 November 18, 2019.

10 **Location:** The banners may be displayed on sign support structures
11 to be installed along Cerrillos Road between I-25 and
12 Rodeo Road.

13 **Number:** An additional thirty (30) banners may be displayed, for a
14 total of fifty (50) banners.

15 **Design Approval Process:** The design of the banners is the same as the design
16 previously approved by the Land Use Director and City
17 Attorney as conforming to all applicable requirements
18 and restrictions as part of the approval of Resolution
19 2019-23.

20 **Installation:** The Public Works Department will install all sign
21 support structures and banners associated with this
22 request.

23 **Maintenance:** Banners that become damaged, defaced, or are in any
24 form of disrepair shall be replaced immediately at the
25 expense of the American Legion Post 12. The City


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reserves the right to remove any banners the City deems in disrepair prior to their scheduled removal date.


Cost Allocation: The American Legion Post 12 shall be responsible for all costs associated with purchasing the sign support structures and banners. The Public Works Department shall be responsible for all costs associated with installing the sign support structures and banners and for removal of the banners on their scheduled removal date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico Department of Transportation has approved the display of the banners in the Cerrillos Road right-of-way.
