15	WHEREAS, municipal water systems and wastewater systems must make significant		
16	investments to install, upgrade, or replace infrastructure; and		
17	WHEREAS, adequate water and wastewater facilities, in addition to protecting public and		
18	environmental health, enable communities to grow and attract businesses and associated economic		
19	development; and		
20	WHEREAS, through the adoption of the City's ICIP 2021-2025 via Resolution No. 2019-46,		
21	the Governing Body established certain water project priorities for consideration by the 54th legislature		
22	2nd session, 2020; and		
23	WHEREAS, there is an ongoing need for the City of Santa Fe to obtain funding for water and		
24	wastewater projects.		
25	NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COVERNING RODY OF THE		

1	CITY OF SAI	NTA FE that the City Manager is directed in the next year to:
2	1.	Identify, by way of example and not limitations, water, wastewater, water
3		conservation, water treatment, water recycling, water reuse, water storage, water
4		conveyance, water delivery, flood prevention, watershed restoration, watershed
5		management, and other similar project ("Projects") priorities, and research, and
6		identify potential Federal and State funding sources for such Projects;
7	2.	Apply for funding and bring specific agreements for such Projects back through
8		committee for review and approval by the Governing Body;
9	3.	Identify a state legislative priority list of Projects for presentation to the City's
10		legislative delegation; and
11	4.	Submit an application to the New Mexico Water Trust Board, in compliance with New
12		Mexico Water Trust Board policy, for financial assistance from the New Mexico Water
13		Project Fund for all project types eligible for consideration, including but not limited
14		to:
15		a) Water storage, conveyance, and delivery projects;
16		b) Watershed restoration and management projects;
17		c) Endangered Species Act collaborative projects;
18		d) Flood prevention projects; and
19		e) Water conservation, treatment, recycling, and reuse projects.
