11	Section 1. Section 18-1.5 of SFCC 1987 (being Ord. #1981-64, § 5, as amended)
12	is amended to read:
13	18-1.5 Payment of license fees required; assessments; protest.
14	A. All businesses engaging in a type of business enumerated as requiring
15	business licenses under this section shall apply for a business license each year. These
16	businesses shall:
17	(1) Include payment with the application:
18	(2) Show proof of insurance and bond, if the business is so required; and
19	(3) Attest that the business shall comply with the requirements of the
20	Living Wage Ordinance, Section 28-1 SFCC 1987.
21	B. Upon payment of the business license fee, the city shall issue a business
22	license to the applicant unless refused pursuant to Section 3-28-2 NMSA 1978.
23	C. Any business which must have a business license as enumerated in this
24	section shall apply to the city for a business license prior to engaging in business.
25	D. The business license shall be valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance.
