A RESOLUTION

**APPROVING THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION PLAN FOR BANNERS
COMMEMORATING VETERANS ALONG THE CERRILLOS ROAD CORRIDOR
BETWEEN I-25 AND RODEO ROAD TO BE DISPLAYED EVERY YEAR BETWEEN
MEMORIAL DAY AND VETERANS DAY.**

WHEREAS, Santa Fe City Code Section 14-8.10 allows for the installation of banners erected by the City of Santa Fe ("City") or its permittee if approved by the Governing Body via Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution regarding installation of banners must specify dates of display, location, number, design approval process, installation, maintenance, and cost allocation; and

WHEREAS, the banners will commemorate the lives of those local veterans who are serving, have served, or have been honorably discharged from the United States Military; and

WHEREAS, the banners are intended to draw attention to Memorial Day and Veterans Day, which are among the most respected of the country's national holidays; and




Cost Allocation: The American Legion Post 12 shall be responsible for all costs associated with purchasing, installation, and removal of the banners, other than the personnel costs.
