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10 **A RESOLUTION**

11 **REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-36; AND ACCEPTING A MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL**
12 **PROGRAM (“MAP”) COOPERATIVE GRANT FROM THE NEW MEXICO**
13 **DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (“NMDOT”) IDENTIFIED AS CONTROL**
14 **NUMBER L500429 FOR THE PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION OF AGUA**
15 **FRIA STREET AND SOUTH MEADOWS ROAD INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS.**

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17 **WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 2020-36, adopted by the Governing Body on September 9,
18 2020, contained an incorrect Control Number in the title of the Resolution; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the correct Control Number is required to submit accurate documents to the
20 New Mexico Department of Transportation (“NMDOT”) to accept the Municipal Arterial Program
21 (“MAP”) cooperative grant; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the NMDOT has sent out a call for applications for MAP grant funds for FY
23 2021/2022; and

24 **WHEREAS**, an intersection improvement project for Agua Fria Street and South Meadows
25 Road has been identified as a priority by the Santa Fe Metropolitan Planning Organization and placed

1 in the Metropolitan Transportation Plan; and

2 **WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Fe (“City”) has placed the intersection improvement project
3 for Agua Fria Street/South Meadows Road Intersection (“Project”) on the Capital Improvement Plan
4 (“CIP”) for design and construction from FY 2017 through FY 2022; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the intersection improvement project for Agua Fria Street and South Meadows
6 Road has been placed on the Infrastructure Capital Improvements Plan (“ICIP”) as a City wide
7 priority for Legislative funding for FY 2022-2026; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the intersection of Agua Fria Street and South Meadows Road is experiencing
9 delays associated with continued growth due to current development in the area; and

10 **WHEREAS**, future development will add to existing delays at the intersection; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the City received \$25,000.00 in capital outlay funding from the 2015
12 Legislature for design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the City received \$100,000.00 in capital outlay funding from the 2018
14 Legislature to purchase rights-of-way and to plan, design, and construct road improvements at the
15 intersection of Agua Fria Street and South Meadows Road; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the City received \$125,000.00 in capital outlay funding from the 2019
17 Legislature to plan, design, and construct rights-of-way improvements to Agua Fria Street and South
18 Meadows Road; and

19 **WHEREAS**, in FY 2019/2020 the City received \$440,750.00 through the NMDOT
20 Municipal Arterial Program (MAP) grant program requiring a City match of \$146,917.00 for a total
21 grant agreement amount of \$587,667.00; and

22 **WHEREAS**, in FY 2020/2021 the City received the City received \$113,869.00 through the
23 NMDOT MAP grant program requiring a City match of \$37,956.00 for a total grant agreement
24 amount of \$151,825.00; and

25 **WHEREAS**, in FY 2021/2022 the City applied and received funds for the Project through

1 the MAP administered by the NMDOT; and

2 **WHEREAS**, the MAP cooperative agreement requires a 25% local match; and

3 **WHEREAS**, in FY 2021/2022 the City received \$162,000.00 through the NMDOT MAP
4 grant program requiring a City match of \$54,000.00 for a total grant agreement amount of
5 \$216,000.00.

6 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE**
7 **CITY OF SANTA FE** that Resolution No. 2020-36 is repealed.

8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Governing Body supports the \$216,000.00 Project
9 MAP award through the NMDOT (Control No. L500429).


10 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City of Santa Fe accepts responsibility for the
11 Project; assumes the lead role in design development and construction of the Project; agrees to the
12 terms, conditions, and certification and reporting requirements of the MAP cooperative project
13 agreement; and assumes ownership, liability, and maintenance responsibilities for all amenities
14 related to the completion of the Project.
