20	Fiscal Year 2022 (FFY22) Section 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with
21	Disabilities program funds for an amount up to \$360,000, as set forth by the Federal legislation,
22	Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act); and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SANTA FE, NEW MEXICO that:

- 1. The City of Santa Fe authorizes the City Manager to submit an application for FFY22 Section 5310 funds for an amount up to \$360,000 to NMDOT on behalf of the residents of
- 2. The City of Santa Fe authorizes the use of the 1/4 cent Gross Receipts Tax dedicated to the Transit Division by Ordinance 2016-5 for the required twenty percent local match if the grant is awarded.
- 3. The City of Santa Fe authorizes the City Manager to enter into a Cooperative Project Agreement with the NMDOT for Section 5310 projects using these funds as set forth by FAST Act on behalf of the residents of City of Santa Fe if the grant is awarded. The City Manager is also authorized to submit additional information as may be required and act as the official representative of the City of Santa Fe for the activities related to this application.
- The City of Santa Fe assures the NMDOT that if Section 5310 funds are awarded, sufficient funding for the local match is available, a check to the awarded vendor for the local match will be sent to NMDOT, and that any costs exceeding the award amount will be paid for by City of
- 5. The City of Santa Fe assures the NMDOT that if awarded Section 5310 funds, sufficient funding for the operation and maintenance of the Section 5310 capital will be available for the life of the project.
- 6. The City of Santa Fe assures the NMDOT that the City of Santa Fe is willing and able to administer all activities associated with the proposed project.
