9		apartment unit, condominium unit, mobile home, or a guest house.				
10		• For commercial customers: an area constituting a separate, independent				
11	}	enterprise establishment for owner occupancy, or rental or lease and physically				
12		separated from any other commercial units that may be in the same structure and				
13		containing independent plumbing facilities.				
14		• For both residential and commercial purposes, the term unit does not include a				
15		motel or hotel unit or similar transient lodging or rest homes, nursing homes or				
16		similar institutional facilities.
