11 **DIRECTING STAFF TO APPLY FOR A SIX MONTH EXTENSION TO AN EXISTING**
12 **MUNICIPAL ARTERIAL PROGRAM FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE NEW**
13 **MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF SANTA FE**
14 **FOR THE OLD PECOS TRAIL RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT – CORDOVA ROAD**
15 **TO BERGER STREET.**

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17 **WHEREAS**, the City of Santa Fe and the New Mexico Department of Transportation
18 (NMDOT) are currently involved in a Municipal Arterial Program (MAP) Agreement providing
19 \$200,000 for the Old Pecos Trail Reconstruction project from Cordova Road to Berger Street
20 comprised of \$150,000 in NMDOT funding with a City match of \$50,000; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the MAP agreement is set to expire on December 31, 2009; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the City has limited the scope of the project, pertaining to the MAP
23 Agreement, to widening of Old Pecos Trail in front of the Children’s Museum to provide median
24 refuge; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the City is currently in the right-of-way acquisition phase of the project;

2 WHEREAS, the City plans to complete construction of these improvements by June 30,
3 2010.


4 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
5 CITY OF SANTA FE that City staff is directed to submit an application to the New Mexico
6 Department of Transportation for a six month extension to the Municipal Arterial Funding
7 Agreement for the Old Pecos Trail Reconstruction Project from Cordova Road to Berger Street,
8 Project Number MAP-4732(900)01, Control Number 5176.

9 PASSED, APPROVED, and ADOPTED this 9th day of December, 2009.


