In addition, the Mayor with the advice and consent of the 25

14		the Planning Commission deems appropriate. The ad hoc subcommittee
15		shall be comprised of volunteer citizens, City staff, and/or commission
16		members.
17	(2)	The chairman of the Planning Commission may appoint ad hoc
